Meeting Rules

The following is a list of rules that the Scouts of Troop 53 are expected to follow. If you do not follow these rules you will be dealt with by the Junior Leaders, Scout Master, or other adults including the Troop Committee.

Respect who is speaking. "When the Scout sign goes up, we become respectful listeners."

1. Keep your hands to yourself.
2. Meetings are scheduled most Monday nights during the school year, unless notified, from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. at the McFarland Lutheran Church.
3. Respect others, no name calling.
4. No swearing or profane language.
5. Call your leader if you have a problem.
6. Come in appropriate dress:
 - a. Troop Meetings — Class A shirt at a minimum.
 - b. Parades, Family Festival, Flag Ceremonies, Court of Honor, Eagle Court, other "formal activities": Neckerchief, slide, sash, belt, pants, hiking boots, no shorts, stretch pants or tennis shoes.
 - c. To Camp — Class A shirt
 - d. Class B for Troop activities including field trips at camp, pancake breakfast.
7. Scouts should consider all parts of the building, except specified areas, out of bounds.
8. Scouts' knives only.
9. No food, no toys, or other distractions.
10. Bring Scout and Leadership books.
11. Leave with what you brought.
12. No hats worn at meetings.
13. No rude, sarcastic remarks.
14. No horsing around or playing with church equipment (i.e. lights, wheelchairs, etc).
15. Remember we are guests of the church.
