

Troop 53 Consequences Policy

This progressive list of consequences may be enforced for Scouts who are not following Expectations of the Troop, Meeting Rules, and/or Campout Rules established by Troop 53. The decision to enforce any of these consequences will be handled by the Scoutmaster or Assistant Scoutmaster(s) or designee(s) based on the facts of the situation. The Scout's parent(s) will be notified if their son receives a consequence from this list.

The Scout will be approached by a Scout Leader, parent, or older scout and be asked to stop the behavior.

The Scout will be asked to leave an activity.

The Scout will be asked to leave the meeting.

The Scout will be suspended from several meetings. The Scoutmaster, parent(s), and Scout will meet before the Scout returns to the regular meetings or activities.

The Scout will be asked to participate in a Board of Review comprised of two Troop Committee members and either the SPL or ASPL for persistent failure to follow Troop rules.

The Scout will have rank advancement deferred for up to 3 months until he demonstrates he has improved his behavior.

The Scout's parent(s) will be called and the Scout will be sent home immediately in the event of any behavior endangering the safety of other Scouts or the Scout himself. A follow up meeting will occur between the Scoutmaster or designee, the Committee Chairperson or designee the Scout, and the parent(s) before he will be allowed to return to regular Scout activities. Other consequences may be enforced in this situation.
